An introduction to Timber Preservation and Damp Treatment in buildings

Course tutor: Peter Macdonald

A one day course ideally suited for preservation treatment technicians and those embarking on a career in the building preservation industry.

The course consists of three parts:

1. Rising Damp:

An introduction to rising damp – diagnosis - treatment options – installation and performance of different damp proof course systems – replastering associated with rising damp – difficult damp treatment situations.

2. Timber Preservation:

Dry rot, wet rot and the control of wood rotting fungi. Common wood boring insects – identification – treatment materials and methods - how to treat a roof, floor and stairs.

3. Health and Safety:

A brief look at Health and Safety issues associated with the treatment of timber and damp - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Control of Substances Hazardous to Health regulations (COSHH) – Risk Assessment – Product Labels – Safety Data

The course is a PowerPoint presentation run by Peter Macdonald who is an independent Building Preservation Consultant with over 37 years of experience in the building preservation industry. The course is completely independent and not connected to any manufacturer, products or materials. A certificate will be provided for those who complete the course.

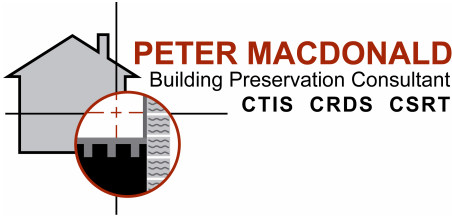
